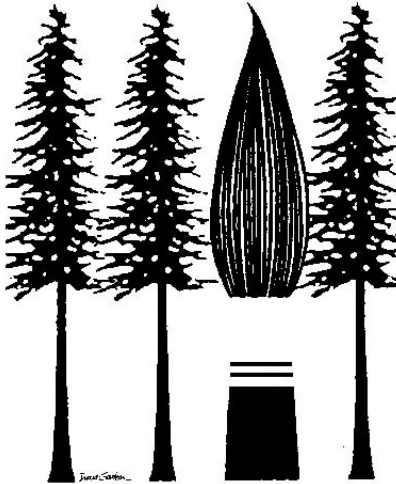

RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

All works must be:

- originals entered by living artist. Originals are one of a kind or limited numbered edition of multiples.
- exhibited in Art in the Redwoods for the first time.
- created within the last 2 years.
- designated *competitive* or *non-competitive*.
- limited to **3** (three) per artist. See **REQUIREMENTS** box.

Gualala Arts reserves the right :

- to change category classification of any entry.
- in its sole discretion to refuse to display any artwork

Gualala Arts Hanging Committee has complete discretion placing or positioning entries. Artists may not request location of their work.

• Competitive or Non-Competitive

Entries will be entered as *competitive* as a default if form is not marked. Artists who won Place Award Ribbons in 2003 may not compete in that same category in 2004. They may, however:

- enter the same category *non-competitively*.
- enter works *competitively* in other categories.
- retain eligibility for the awards for Most Popular Artist.

ENTRY RULES

Fees

- Gualala Arts members: \$10 each artwork.
- Non-members: \$30 annual membership fee, then \$10 each work.
- Checks should be made payable to *Gualala Arts*.
- Entry fees are not refundable.
- A \$5 charge will be applied to any Entry Form changes made after July 25. Changes made after August 15 may not be reflected in the *Independent Coast Observer's Art* in the Redwoods Official Show Program.
- **Write neatly, fill in all the blanks, and double-check your spelling and entry information.**

Commissions

- Gualala Arts will retain 25% commission on all sales made during the course of the exhibit.

Entry Procedure:

- Prepare a three-part Entry Form for **EACH** work entered. Blank entry forms may be photocopied.
- Mail Section 1 with correct fees to Art in the Redwoods, P. O. Box 244, Gualala, CA 95445.
- Entry Form must be postmarked no later than Friday, July 26, 2004.
- Attach Section 2 securely to back of artwork to be entered.
- Present Section 3 when work is delivered (August 15) and picked up (September 12, 13, & 14). Use Section 3, after it is signed by an authorized representative, for free entry to the festival and as proof of ownership.

- **ENTRY FORMS POSTMARKED AFTER JULY 26 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!**

Deliver all artwork:

- ⇒ to Gualala Arts Center at 46501 Old State Highway, in Gualala, on Sunday, August 15, between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- We will not accept entries shipped or mailed. All entries must be delivered in person to Gualala Arts Center at the above designated delivery time. **No exceptions.**
- Artists may not remove artwork prior to close of the Art in the Redwoods exhibit (before September 12).

- Buyers may take purchased artwork anytime after August 22.

Pick up all work:

- ⇒ between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Sunday, September 12, Monday, September 13, or Tuesday, September 14, at Gualala Arts Center.
- ⇒ by presenting Entry Section 3 as proof of ownership, or by presenting Buyer's Sales Receipt.
- Works not picked up will be stored at Gualala Arts Center at the re-

REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY SIZE, FRAMING, DISPLAY, ETC.

Due to the volume of work we receive, these rules must be followed.

1. Have sturdy frames on all pictures-- they will be tested. No plastic or "fast" frames; **no sawtooth hangers**- sturdy wires only. Plexiglas preferred.
2. Ensure paintings are thoroughly dry.
3. **For all wall hung art entries, only one can be a maximum of 60" in width. Additional entries must be 48" or less.**
4. **Quilts over 60" are allowed if they may be hung outside. Provide quilts with hanging tabs or sleeves, and labeled poles.**
5. If several pieces come as a set to be hung together, their total dimensions should not exceed 60" in width. Each piece will be considered as one entry.
6. Size limits will be strictly adhered to, and entries may be deleted if space limitations require.
7. Entries may be refused because of fragility.
8. Provide assistance in handling large three-dimensional entries.
9. Provide stands for proper display where needed.
10. **Enclose jewelry and small sculptures in display cases or shadow box frames for protection.**

RESPONSIBILITY

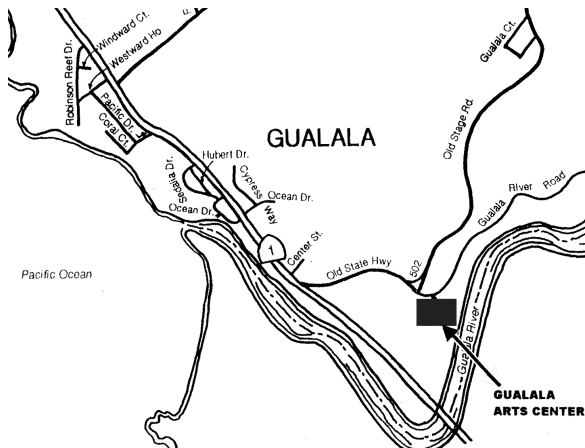
- Security is provided, however, Gualala Arts, Inc. is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of artworks entered in show.
- Exhibitors are solely responsible for their work and should insure work if they desire.
- Submission of entries implies acceptance of all conditions stated in these rules.
- If mailing is required of purchased fragile art, the artist is responsible for packaging and mailing of the piece to the buyer.

The 43rd annual **Art in the Redwoods Festival** will be presented on August 21 & 22, 2004, at the Gualala Arts Center in Gualala, California. Gualala overlooks the Pacific Ocean at the junction of Mendocino and Sonoma Counties, 115 miles north of San Francisco.

Artists and artisans are invited to show and sell their works, and to compete for awards of over \$3,800. Last year, sales of artworks earned artists over \$20,000.

Art in the Redwoods is a major art event for the North Coast, and last year featured nearly 500 entries from 207 artists, while attracting over 3,000 viewers from near and far.
