

# Gualala Arts' Summer Art Program for Youth

**DATES: Tuesday through Friday, July 8 - 11, 2008**

All children are invited to participate in this year's **Summer Art Program for Youth**, sponsored by Gualala Arts. This program has been extremely popular in its' past 17 years, and area students wishing to participate are encouraged to sign up as soon as possible. Pre-schoolers will receive a 3-hour Art & Physical Education program taught by Lena Bullamore. Students in grades 1 through 6 are offered a choice of two consecutive classes of 1½ hours each.

**COMING AND GOING . . . Children must be signed in and out every day.** Children should arrive at Gualala Arts Center at 9:30 a.m. (**9:15 a.m. the first day**). They are supervised from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., and **must be picked up promptly at 12:30 p.m.** Each child should bring a snack with his/her name on the container each day.

## **PRE-SCHOOL AGES 3 – 4 – 5**

**Art and Physical Education** ~ taught by Lena Bullamore. This self-contained class, with indoor and outdoor activities, is directed by a fine teacher who is well-known on our coast for her many years of working with young children. In this 3-hour program, children will participate in movement, drama, games, music and visual art, all in a safe environment that encourages creativity in art, and body awareness in movement.

## **GRADES 1 – 2 – 3, AND GRADES 4 – 5 – 6**

The classes described below are offered to students in groups of grades 1-2-3, and grades 4-5-6. Students enroll in two 1½-hour classes, for a total of three hours each day. Choose among:

**Ceramics** ~ **Jan Maria Chiappa** Students will create in clay, animals, flower pots, plates, mugs, mobiles and other creations with slab work. Students will experience glazing techniques with home-created glazes.

**Music/Singing** ~ **Renata Yardumian** Students will learn about music in a safe supportive atmosphere. This year's group will work towards a recital of their own. Music will be focused on piano, voice, percussion and some history. Students will learn about famous musicians from 1600-present.

**Creative Arts and Crafts** ~ **Gerda Randolph** Students in this class will explore a variety of craft projects including felting, weaving, rock painting and the making of puppets, beads, sculptures, and picture wheels. Activities will be designed to encourage the unique creativity of each child.

**Irish Dance** ~ **Stacy Roumas** ~ Back by popular demand! Traditional Irish Dancing classes are taught to promote Irish culture in a fun, family like atmosphere. This class will teach the basics of traditional Irish dance including the Reel, Jig, Single Jig and Slip Jig. Students will be encouraged to learn at their own rate.

**Culinary Art** ~ **David 'Sus' Susalla** Students will learn the art of basic kitchen health and safety, how to set a table, create a menu, prepare and serve it. Students will get to vote on more than half of the cooking projects. This will be very hands on class, and they will get to take home goodies to share on a few days. Bring your ideas and wishes on what types of fruits, vegetables, and cultures you would like to learn about!

**Drawing / Painting / Photography** ~ **Bruce Jones & Jamie McHugh** Each day students will learn various techniques of creating art. Students will travel time, Gualala Arts trails, and classrooms learning techniques and skills of the past present and future. A wide variety of media will be explored.
