Information

Entry fee: There is a \$15.00 entry fee for up to three pieces. Make checks payable to Gualala Arts.

All Work Must Be for Sale: Gualala Arts will retain 30% of the selling price. Checks for art work sold will be mailed to artist within two weeks of the end of the month in which it was sold. Any shipping of art work must be arranged between buyer and artist. One of three pieces may be NFS with prior arrangement.

Eligibility: This juried exhibit is open to all artists. All entries must be original work created by the interlacing of warp and weft.

Selection: Work for this exhibit will be selected from digital images and photos. Artists may submit up to three pictures or digital images of each piece (no slides please).

To Enter: By **Mail** send completed entry form (one for each piece), entry fee, and photos or digital images on CD to: Warp and Weft Curator, c/o Gualala Arts Center, P.O. Box 244, Gualala CA 95445. By **Email** send digital images in jpg format, scaled to 72 dpi with 1000 pixels maximum in the longest dimension, to janhaverty@gmail.com and identify each picture with artist's name and entry title or number. Mail completed entry form(s) and entry fee same as above.

Entry Deadline: Entry form, fees, and images must be received by July 1st, 2009

Notification of Acceptance: Artists will be notified by email, or by phone if no email, on or before July 15, 2009.

Delivery of Work: All entries must be delivered to the Gualala Art Center between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. Wednesday September 9th, 2009. If you plan to ship entry or hand deliver at an earlier date please contact the curator to make arrangements.

Ready to Hang: All entries must be ready to hang. It is the responsibility of the artist to provide suitable hanging devices. Instructions for hanging preferences are welcomed.

Insurance: Exhibitors are solely responsible for their work and should insure work if they desire. Gualala Arts, Inc. is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of artworks entered in this exhibit.

Artist Statement: Please include a bio or artist statement and picture of artist to be included in the Gallery information notebook.
