Dates to Remember

- Turn in your signed Entry Form ASAP, no later than Tuesday, December 29, 2009.
- Deliver artwork Tuesday, January 5, 2010, 10 am to 2 pm
- Opening Reception: Saturday, January 9, 2010, 5 pm to 7 pm
- Voting begins at the Reception and ends Noon, January 18
Winners will be posted January 19
- For art not sold, take down is Monday, February 1, 2010, 10 am to 4 pm.



Exhibit Description:

Unlike juried exhibits where a panel of "experts" decide which artists get to show their work, all submissions for this exhibit will be accepted. Each artist may submit two pieces of original 2D or 3D artwork, all media are welcome. Usually exhibits are not judged, but this one is an exception with a fun twist. For this exhibit, the judges are the viewing public, whose votes will determine which artists get the prize money and the prestige of winning. There will be three levels of awards (\$300, \$200 and \$100).

All Works of Art Must Be:

- Originals which are one of a kind or limited numbered edition of multiples and are entered and created by a living artist.
- Exhibited in "You be the Judge" exhibit for the first time.
- Created within the last 2 years.
- Limited to 2 (two) per artist. See Requirements below.

Requirements for Entry Size, Framing, Display, etc.

Due to the volume of work we receive, these rules MUST be followed:

1. Have sturdy frames on all pictures—they will be tested. No plastic or "clip" frames; no saw tooth hangers; sturdy wires only. Plexiglas preferred. Hang from a metal picture wire with a minimum of 2 inches from the top of frame to ensure that wire and hanger will not show.
2. Ensure paintings are thoroughly dry.
3. For all wall-hung art entries, only one can be a maximum of 60" in width. Second entry must be 48" or less. Glass entries see rule #10.
4. Quilts must provide hanging tabs or sleeves, and labeled poles.
5. If pieces come as a set to be hung together, their total dimensions should not exceed 60" in width. Each piece will be considered as one entry.
6. Size limits will be strictly adhered to, and entries may be refused if space limitations require, or because of fragility.
7. The general weight limit for pieces is 80 pounds. Exceptions can be made by prior arrangement (see Exceptions and Special Circumstances below).
8. Provide assistance in handling large three-dimensional entries and provide stands for proper display where needed (see Exceptions and Special Circumstances below).
9. Enclose jewelry and small sculptures in display cases or shadow box frames for protection.
10. Exceptions and special circumstances: For pieces above the weight limit, glass entries to be suspended, and all unusually complex or fragile pieces, artist participation in placement is required. Contact the curator (Barry Semegran at 707-884-4606) before January 1, 2010, to make arrangements for assistance.
11. No supplemental labels, descriptions, books, promotional materials, etc., are allowed next to or around entry, without consent of the curator, Barry Semegran, 707-884-4606.
12. GA carries no inventory of multiples. Artist is responsible for delivery of multiple sales and/or mailing.

Entry Fees

- GA members: \$25 for up to two pieces of artwork. Non-members: \$35 for up to two pieces of artwork.
- Checks should be made payable to "Gualala Arts". Entry fees are not refundable.
- A \$5 charge will be applied for any changes to Entry Form information made after submission.

Commissions

- GA will retain 30% commission on all sales made during the course of the exhibit.
- Checks for artwork sold will be mailed to the artist within two weeks of the end of the month in which it was sold. If the exhibit generates future commissions, it is the policy of GA to request that 10% of those sales be sent to GA.

Entry Procedure

- Prepare an Entry Form for EACH work entered.
- Mail in with correct fees to "You be the Judge Entry", PO Box 244, Gualala, CA 95445 or turn into Dolphin/GA Office.
- A label will be generated by GA to attach to the back of the artwork on take-in day.
- A receipt will be generated and given to you on art take-in day to present for pick up of unsold artwork.

Artwork Delivery

- Deliver all artwork to Gualala Arts Center at 46501 Gualala Road, in Gualala, on Tuesday, January 5, 2010 between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- We will not accept entries shipped or mailed. All entries must be delivered in person to Gualala Arts Center at the above designated delivery time. No exceptions.
- Work must stay up for entire exhibit.
- Packing items will not be stored or returned to artist.
- Wall glass, large sculptures, or any work needing special attention must be arranged with the Curator, Barry Semegran, 707-884-4606.

Artwork Pickup

- Pickup unsold artwork between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Monday, February 1 at the Gualala Arts Center by presenting Artist Receipt as proof of ownership.
- Works not picked up will be stored at Gualala Arts Center at the responsibility of the artist and at a charge of \$5 per day per piece.

Responsibility

- Exhibitors are solely responsible for their work and should insure work if they desire.
- Gualala Arts, Inc. is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of artworks entered in show.
- Gualala Arts may require proof of insurance if work is priced over \$5,000.
- Submission of entries implies acceptance of all conditions stated in the above rules.
- If mailing is required of purchased art, the artist will be asked if they wish to ship the art. The artist will be responsible for packaging and mailing of the piece to the buyer.

GUALALA ARTS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO:

- Refuse to display any artwork.
- Display and hang the artwork; artists may not request the location of their work
