EXHIBIT CONCEPT

All Ceramics and Nothing but Ceramics is intended as a straight forward single media exhibit to showcase the full variety of ceramic art on the North Coast, whether craft, functional or fine art; 3-D or 2-D, high or low fired, glazed or unglazed. The goal is to fill the venue with a broad sampling of current ceramic work being produced by artists in the community.

THE ARTISTS

This show will be open to all artists in the community in its broadest sense. New work completed in the last two years will be required. All work will be for sale unless exempted by the Curator. Only ceramic media and mixed media that includes ceramic plus other media will be accepted, whether 2-D or 3-D work. Artists may enter a maximum of three pieces. Every effort will be made to obtain the broadest participation possible and to include all ceramicists in the area including those that do not normally exhibit at the Gualala Art Center.

RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

- Each artist can enter 3 pieces.
- Both 2D and 3D work will be accepted.
- The entry fee for Gualala Arts members (up to 3 pieces) is \$20. For non-members (up to 3 pieces) is \$35. Checks must be made payable to Gualala Arts.
- Please include a 5"X7" photo or image file of the artist/s that will be placed next to the work. If you cannot supply a photo or image file, a photograph will be taken on Delivery Day.
- Each entry must be entered by a living artist who created the entry within the past two years. Entries must never have been exhibited at Gualala Arts before.
- No other supplemental labels, descriptions, books, promotional materials, etc., are allowed next to or around an entry. A binder with one 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper per entry will provide a description of the entry and the artist's biography. The binder will be available in the gallery for public viewing.

COMMISSIONS

- Gualala Arts will retain 30% commission on all sales of entries (or multiples) made during the course of the exhibit.
- Checks for artwork sold will be mailed to the artist within two weeks of the end of the month in which it was sold. If the exhibit generates future commissions, it is the policy of Gualala Arts to request that 10% of those sales be sent to Gualala Arts.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

- Each artist should sign an entry form and send to Gualala Arts.
- Print clearly, fill in all contact blanks, and double-check spelling.
- Prepare a list with name of piece and price for curator. This list will be entered into the Gualala Arts database and used for selling and sending checks to the artists. It is also the contact information if a client wants to contact an artist.

ARTWORK DELIVERY

- Deliver artwork to Gualala Arts Center at 46501 Gualala Road, in Gualala. You and the curator will verify all title card information on delivery day between 10am and 2pm.
- Gualala Arts will not accept shipped or mailed entries. No exceptions!

POST SHOW PICK UP

- Unsold work must stay up for the entire exhibit; however, buyers may take purchased artwork after Opening Reception.
- Artists must claim unsold work on Take Down Day by 4 p.m.
- Gualala Arts is not responsible for works not picked up by 4 p.m. on Take Down Date and will charge \$5 per day per piece for storage.
- Packing items will not be returned to artists.

RESPONSIBILITY

- Gualala Arts, Inc. is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of artworks entered in the show.
- Exhibitors are solely responsible for their work and should insure work if they desire. Gualala Arts may require proof of insurance if a work is priced over \$5,000.
- Gualala Arts will not ship purchases. If an entry requires mailing to a potential purchaser, Gualala Arts will contact the artist. If the artist wishes to package and mail the piece
