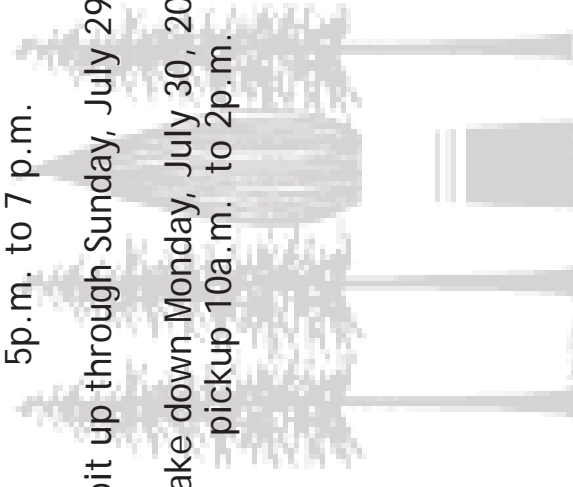
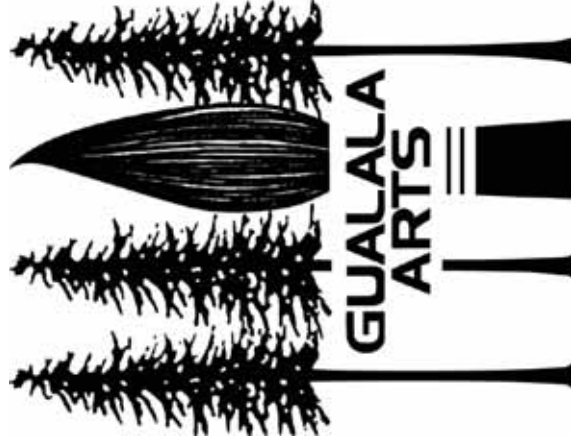

Exhibit Concept

"Warps and Wefts" the exhibit, is a challenge to all Artists, not just Weavers, to create a work utilizing the interlacing of lengthwise materials (warp) with crosswise materials (weft). It is a call to interpret, to adapt, and to merge this warp and weft structure into your own artistic concept. Cultures the world over have used this structure for centuries to weave textiles and baskets, utilizing wool, plant fiber, wood, metal, plastic, and paper. What can you make using this structure?

Rules

This juried exhibit is open to all artists. All entries must be original work created by the interlacing of warp and weft, and not have been shown at previous 'Warp and Weft' exhibits at Gualala Arts.

Entry fee

\$15 for 1-3 pieces.

\$15 additional for each not for sale piece.

All entries must be ready to hang. It is the responsibility of the artist to provide suitable hanging devices. Instructions for hanging preferences are welcomed.

If you plan to ship your entry or if you plan hand deliver your entry at an earlier date please contact the curator to make arrangements

Selection

Works for this exhibit will be selected from digital images and photos. Artists may submit up to three pictures or digital images of each piece (no slides please). Email digital images in jpg format, scaled to 72 dpi with 1000 pixels maximum in the longest dimension, to jennie@jleeh.biz. Identify each picture with artist's name and entry title or number.

Notification of Acceptance will be by email, or by phone if no email, on or before June 1, 2012

PREPARING ENTRIES

- No supplemental labels, descriptions, books, promotional materials, etc., are allowed next to or around an entry. A binder with one 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper per entry will provide a description of the entry and the artist's biography. The binder will be available in the gallery for public viewing.

FEES

- Checks should be made payable to Gualala Arts.
- Entry fees are not refundable.

COMMISSIONS

- Gualala Arts will retain 30% commission on all sales of entries (or multiples) made during the course of the exhibit.
- Checks for artwork sold will be mailed to the artist within two weeks of the end of the month in which it was sold. If the exhibit generates future commissions, it is the policy of Gualala Arts to request that 10% of those sales be sent to Gualala Arts.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

- Each artist should sign an entry form for each piece entered.
- Print clearly, fill in all contact blanks, and double-check spelling.

ARTWORK DELIVERY

- Deliver artwork to Gualala Arts Center at 46501 Gualala Road, in Gualala.
- Gualala Arts will not accept shipped or mailed entries. No exceptions!
- An artist receipt will be given to you for each entry on "take in" day to present for claiming unsold artwork.

POST SHOW PICK UP

- Unsold work must stay up for the entire exhibit; however, buyers may take purchased artwork after Opening Reception.
- Artists must claim unsold work on Take Down Date by 4 p.m.
- Gualala Arts is not responsible for works not picked up by 4 p.m. on Take Down Day and will charge \$5 per day per piece for storage.
- Packing items will not be returned to artists.

RESPONSIBILITY

- Gualala Arts, Inc. is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of artworks entered in the show.
- Exhibitors are solely responsible for their work and should insure work if they desire. Gualala Arts may require proof of insurance if a work is priced over \$5,000.
- Gualala Arts will not ship purchases. If an entry requires mailing to a potential purchaser, Gualala Arts will contact the artist. If the artist wishes to package and mail the piece to the buyer, Gualala Arts will complete the purchase.
- Submission of an entry implies acceptance of all conditions stated in this document.
