

Supply List for Hand Quilting Class

In this class we will be discussing the technique of hand quilting, methods, tools and notions. We will also be practicing the techniques we will learn. We will learn to sandwich and baste a small quilt for hand quilting.

Please bring the following to class:

Small pieced top or printed whole fabric (100% cotton, prewashed)

Fabric for backing (3" larger than top on all sides)

4 pieces of muslin, 18-24" square (To be used in practicing with stencils)

Batting, twin sized; low loft; preferable cotton

Pkg of quilting needles (called "betweens")

Hand quilting thread to match your pieced top or printed whole fabric (Can also be used on muslin practice squares)

Contrasting thread for basting

Masking or painter's tape

Comfortable thimble

Fabric scissors

Thread snips

12-18J" quilting hoop (Embroidery hoops are too tight and often too flimsy)

Marking utensil (I prefer chalk-based markers, but any water soluble marker will do)

I will be bringing a number of tools and notions for you to try, including quite a few stencils with which you may practice.
