

**HAND APPLIQUE  
GAIL SIMS  
SUPPLY LIST**

Cotton scraps that you would like to mix together in fat quarter pieces.

Wool scraps (100% wool works best). The new Moda wool is OK -good for the buttonhole technique. Wool felt is personally my least favorite but some people love it. Bring what you can easily come up with.

Needles and Threads: (Size 11-12 sharps or millners) I will provide silk thread in different colors for you to try on the cotton appliqué but Metler and Coats and Clark embroidery thread is also very good. Bring a color to match your material.

Size 7 needles for the wool work. Cotton thread to match the wool colors you have. Bring a black embroidery floss for the buttonhole stitch.

Spray starch

Small paint brush (for the starch – not a good quality brush)

Stilletto

A few toothpicks

If you have a very small appliqué iron, bring it. I will have two but the more we have, the better.

If you have circle or leaf plastic templates (don't go buy them if you just want to try them first, I have some)
