MATERIALS LIST

- * Coat pattern that fits you (Rachel will have her pattern available for sale)
- * Sewing machine and extra needles
- * Extension cord (if required for facilities)
- * Iron (optional)
- * Basic sewing kit
- * Pencil and notepad
- * Tracing or pattern paper (examination table paper)
- * Rotary cutter and board
- * Omnigrid ruler or quilter's rule
- * Scotch tape (optional)
- * Sense of adventure combined with a sense of humor!
- * Sewing Machine used: Yes

Fabric

- * 15 to 20 print and solid fabrics (welcome to bring more) $\frac{1}{4}$ to 1 yard pieces
- * Base fabric-muslin or flannel (amount required by your pattern) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 3 yards
if using my pattern
- * Embellishments

This workshop is designed to use some of the materials that the student may have collected over the years for that special garment. Students should begin their preparation by collecting their treasures: button, beads, etc. and at least 15 to 20 fabrics.
