MATERIALS LIST

SUPPLIES:

- *Cotton fabrics
- *Quilt Back fabric 21X26 (a small amount will be turned from back and seen from the front)
- *1 piece of batting 21X26 (light weight- Hobbs/Heirloom, Warm& Natural)
- *Sewing machine in good working condition, with zig-zag capability and an appropriate foot for cording or zig-zag stitching
- *Bernina users should bring #21 foot if you have one
- *Yarns for couching
- *Basic sewing supplies
- *Sewing and decorative threads
- *Several safety pins for basting
- *Duckbill Appliqué, sewing and paper scissors
- *Cutting board, ruler and rotary cutter
- *Iron and Ironing board
- *Masking tape
- *Pencil/Eraser
- *Fine line (not ultra-fine) marker (permanent black)
- *Drawing paper
- *Tracing Paper 1-piece 18"x24"
- *Freezer Paper 18" wide

For this workshop you'll need to bring a range of fabrics, small-medium-large scale, light-medium-dark, batiks work well. Let the photos you plan to use be your guide to color, and keep

in mind we'll be working on a quilt that will be 18" x 24.
