

Call to Artists for *Small Works* Exhibit

Small Works is a Gualala Arts members' only, juried show, that runs from February 11 through March 5, 2006, with the opening from 5 to 7 p.m. on February 11. Entries, in any medium, can be no larger than 12 inches in any direction. Judging the exhibit will be Khysie Horn, owner of Quicksilver Mine Co., in Forestville. Educated in social sciences, both in the northeast and at the Western Institute for Social Research, Berkeley, for graduate studies, Khysie switched her interest in 1983 to art. Now in her fourth location, the stunning Quicksilver has evolved into a dedicated contemporary fine art gallery.

When judging a show, Khysie looks at the works, and based on what she sees, she thinks about the exhibit as a whole, as well as evaluating individual pieces. Uniqueness, with a variety of subject matter, medium and approach; artists working outside the box, things that challenge the viewer – these are the qualities that catch her eye.

Applications are available at Gualala Arts, or online at GualalaArts.org. There is a non-refundable \$5 per piece entry fee, maximum two works per person, due with the application no later than January 30, preferably earlier. Delivery of entries to Gualala Arts will be on the morning of February 8. Judging will take place that afternoon, and artists will receive a phone call by 4:00 p.m. for notification of any pieces that are not accepted. These works can be picked up between 4:00 and 5:00 that day.


