All entry pieces must be hand-delivered to the Gualala Arts Center on **October 11 from 10 a.m. to noon**. **Artists not selected will be notified between 4 and 5 p.m. and asked to pick up works between 5 and 5:30. ## Wet Paint – the Best of 2006

The North Coast Artists Guild will again sponsor this annual juried show with prizes of over \$1000 given in at least five categories. All media except video are accepted. **Entry forms and the fee of \$25** (\$35 for non-members of an artists' organization) **should be submitted by December 1**. One or two entries should be **delivered to Gualala Arts Center on Wednesday, December 6 between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.** Artists must return on **Friday, December 8** to pick up non-accepted works. The exhibit will open with a reception on **December 9 from 5 – 7 p.m.** and the art will be on display through January 7, 2007 in the Burnett Gallery. Unsold works must be retrieved on **Monday, January 8, from noon to 4 p.m.**

## Whale &amp; Jazz Poster Challenge

Here is your chance to design a poster for the Whale & Jazz Festival in spring. Entries can be paintings, photos, computer art, graphic art, but must be two-dimensional only.



## Rules and qualifications:

- Entry forms will be available through the GualalaArts.org website, Gualala Arts, and the Dolphin Gallery starting September 15.
- **Art must be received at Gualala Arts by Friday, January 5, 2007. Artists may bring their entry forms and fees with their art on that day.**
- Art must have a theme of whales, jazz or both.
- Art must be on paper or canvas with no mats and no frames.
- Size of the art must be 14"x10."
- Each artist may submit up to three entries. The entry fee is \$25 per piece, which will cover the cost of framing by Gualala Arts. All frames will be black metal, Nielsen "Radius" frames with Plexiglas. All mats will be bright white, precut to 20"x16" outside and 13 3/4"x9 3/4" inside. The artist or buyer will own the mats and frames.
- The artist must give Gualala Arts copying rights so the winning entries may be used in posters to promote the Whale & Jazz Festival.

Judging will be during the week of January 7. Five winners will be selected. Each of the five prize winners will receive a \$50 cash award. Gualala Arts will then scan the winning entries and use the images to produce posters to be distributed electronically and on paper.

If Gualala Arts decides to print posters showing the art, and sell the posters, the artist will receive 10 percent of gross sales of the posters depicting their art.

## Show details:

- The show will be at the Burnett Gallery in Gualala Arts from March 10 to April 8, 2007.
- The framed original art will be for sale by a silent auction ending during the Whale & Jazz Festival in the first week in April, with minimum bids set at \$300. Sales commission to Gualala Arts will be 30 percent.
- Reception will be Saturday, March 10, 5 - 7 p.m.
- Pickup of unsold entries will be on Monday, April 9 and Tuesday, April 10.
