

# 46TH ANNUAL ART IN THE REDWOODS FESTIVAL

## Friday, August 17 Champagne Preview of Fine Art Exhibit

Admission fee: \$10 includes champagne and souvenir glass

Children 12 and under are free. Artists with a stamped entry form are admitted free. Free Parking

**4 p.m. Gate opens** for visitors to preview the over forty artists' vendor booths. Artists from all over Northern California will be selling their artwork and craft items. Beat the crowds, beat the heat (!), meet the artists, and be the first in line to see and get the best of these unique handmade items. Parking is free. All events are handicap accessible with a special parking area.



**4:30 p.m. Doors open for the Champagne Reception for the Art in the Redwoods Fine Art Exhibit** in all five rooms of the Arts Center. There will be complimentary champagne with a souvenir glass of the event. First 100 visitors get special glasses with the date. Artists have been working all year for this largest exhibit of art on the coast. This is the exhibit which shows the widest array of local and Bay Area art. This display of over 400 works of art will be up through September 2. Come back during regular business hours to see the show again at a leisurely pace without charge.



**6 - 7 p.m. Judges' Critiques and Awarding of Prizes** in the JAMI Amphitheater. This year's Art in the Redwood judges, Bill Zimmer, Ann Savageau, and Cheri Ibes will tell why and how they made their choices of the winning works. The Awards Ceremony follows when Sus, Executive Director of Gualala Arts, hands out over \$4000 in prize monies to the winning artists.
