Out Of The Box Exhibit

Registration Deadline: December 12

January 12 through February 3, 2008 will be a juried exhibition sponsored by the North Coast Artists' Guild that is open to all artists. The judges will be Jill D'Alessandro and Werner Reichhold

Jill D'Alessandro, Associate Curator of Textiles, joined the Fine Arts Museums of San Francisco in 2002. She was active in the opening of the new de Young and in the planning of the inaugural exhibition in the textile galleries – Beauty, Power, and Prestige: Textiles and Costume from the Permanent Collection. In 2007 D'Alessandro curated Vivienne Westwood: 36 Years in Fashion and Nan Kempner: American Chic for the museums. She has contributed essays to *Fiberarts*, *Hali*, the North American Textile Conservation Conference, and The Diane and Sandy Besser Collection exhibition catalogue.

Werner Reichhold was born 1925 in Berlin, Germany. He has been known as an installation artist since 1960. His steel sculptures, large size graphite drawings, and photographs have been exhibited in galleries and museums in Europe, North and South America, and in Japan. He

taught art at the Fachhochschule in Hannover, Germany. In 1981, Werner with his wife, Jane, built a house on the ridge between Point Arena and Gualala. Since 1989, Werner has published 10 books of poetry – four as paper books and six as online books. His web site at www.wernerreichhold.com includes his latest inter-genre poetry, written from 1990-2007.

Selection of work for this exhibit will be made from digital images only. Artists are to submit no more than one image for each 2-dimensional piece and two images for each 3-dimensional piece. Attach digital images only, (no slides), jpeg 72 dpi, 6 inches maximum in either direction.
