This very successful fundraising event provides a festive evening of great food and fun. Everyone enjoys the excitement of waiting for their number to be drawn so they can choose either their favorite piece of art or a donated fun experience.

To make this event a success, Gualala Arts will need at least 110 pieces of art and/or non-art items valued at more than \$75. The committee is looking for art you have created or purchased in the past, but are now ready to pass on to a good home. Also popular are items of value that only you can offer, such as dinners, vacation rentals, jewelry, entertainment, etc. All donations are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law.

The donations will be on display at the Arts Center for a week before the event, so everyone can pick their favorites in preparation for the festivities!

We've made the donation process easy for you:

Step 1: Call Susan King at the Arts Center (707-884-1138) and make a verbal commitment by June 7. She will ask for your name, phone number, and a brief description of the item to be donated.

Step 2: Bring your donation to the Arts Center on June 8, between 10:00 a.m.- 2:00 p.m., with its completed form giving a description of your donation and its history. Every donation has a story to tell, making it even more interesting to potential new owners.

There are two levels of tickets for the event. \$30 covers the reception, including food and beverages. The \$70 ticket includes the reception plus a guarantee that you will leave with an item worth at least \$75 that you select when your number is drawn.
